

Paw Trax® Super Absorbent Doggy Pads & Training Tray . . . the simple way to house train your pet!

Training one's pet to "potty" outside is a major goal for pet owners. However, today's busy pet parents are opting more and more for "indoor" house training methods, especially owners of toy breeds and small-medium sized pets. Richell's Paw Trax® Super Absorbent Doggy Pads & Training Tray are just the perfect training tools for indoor use! By following just a few simple steps using the Paw Trax® system, you'll be a whole lot happier and your pet and floors a whole lot drier! Paw Trax® . . . no tracks, no mess, no fuss!



Begin by following the diagramed instructions included on the packaging to attach a "super absorbent pad" to the bottom half of the tray. Place the tray & pad in an area where your pet feels most comfortable. If you prefer to use the training pads without the tray, place the pad on the floor with the plastic side down.

Next, guide your pup from its pen to the pad to introduce your pet to the "potty" area. If your pet does not potty within 5 minutes, place your pup back in its pen. Continue guiding your pet to the pad area every 30 minutes or so until he/she does go. Shower your pet with praise! Then reward your pup by giving him/her a few minutes of **supervised free-time** in the house before placing them back in the pen.

If your pup has an accident, and this will happen during the training process, calmly take your pet to his/her "potty area" for a few minutes before placing them back in the pen. **Never scold or punish your pet!** Clean the spot to remove the pet odor. A good tip is to place the soiled towel or rag on the tray/pad to help guide your pet to the "potty" area. Watch your pup closely during his/her free time in the house. Sniffing and circling are sure indicators that your pup is about to go! Quickly but gently place your pup on the tray/pad.

By the time your pup reaches adulthood, you'll be able to keep the pen door open all the time. Your pet will be able to go to and from his/her potty area as needed without any supervision at all!

Tips:

- **Never punish** your pet by forcing him/her onto the pad/tray.
- **Never** allow your new pup to roam through your house unsupervised.
- **Always praise** your pet whenever he/she "goes potty" on the pad.
- Clean tray using mild soap and warm water; dry using a soft cloth.
