



Caring for your Rubberwood

At Richell USA, we utilize beautiful rubberwood in the design and construction of our pet products. Like all things treasured, each piece must be cared for in order to preserve the natural beauty of the wood. To better assist you, we've provided recommended caring tips to help aid in sustaining the beauty of your Richell wood product for many years to come:

- ~ Although rubberwood is both durable and mold resistant, we recommend that you dust regularly using a damp, soft cloth, then hand-drying with a soft, dry cloth.
- ~ Do not clean the wood surface with harsh abrasives or cleansers containing ammonia or organic solvents as these may damage the lacquer finish. We recommend using mild detergent and warm water, then hand-drying with a soft, dry cloth.
- ~ Because wood typically "clouds" when exposed to liquids for an extended period of time, wipe up spills immediately with a dry, soft cloth.
- ~ Our wood products should not be placed in areas that receive exposure to direct sunlight or heating/cooling ducts for long periods of time. The variations in temperature are neither good for the wood nor your pet.
- ~ All Richell wood pet products, unless otherwise specified, are designed for indoor use only.
- ~ We encourage you to care for and enjoy the simple beauty of your rubberwood product; your pet will love you for it!
